Dear Friedens Family,

This morning my son called to remind me that this is the last day of summer. I thought to myself, "That means tomorrow is the first day of autumn." Yesterday I was out and about in 103 degree summer heat. This morning I was delighted to experience the cool morning autumn air. This was the most dramatic transition from summer to fall that I have ever experienced in my 85 years!

As we move into October I am reminded that October 31 will mark the end of my third year as Transition Pastor at Friedens. That prompted me to start counting blessings. The biggest blessing on my list is the joy of serving with you for these years.

The next blessing that comes to mind is the 25 years that I have served with the people of the ELCA, Nebraska Synod, in prison ministry. 25 years have passed very quickly. Thanks to generous donors (money and goods) we have shared the Good News with partners in the prisons, and served thousands of men and women as they struggled to re-enter society.

Each year we have planned a Freed for Life event, usually at Sheridan Lutheran Church, to celebrate our ministry and raise funds to keep it growing. To get a sense of the scope of that ministry I would invite you to visit the warehouse that houses Bridges to Hope, Bud's Thrift Shoppe on O Street, and the FEAST, on Sunday morning at Our Saviours Lutheran Church.

You are all invited to a 25th Anniversary celebration on November 6th at Sheridan Lutheran Church from 3:00 to 5:00 pm. Instead of dinner we will serve hors d'oeuvres and anniversary cake. You are invited to come to meet some ex-prisoners and current prisoners from the FEAST program. You will be moved by the three minute video testimonies of about ten (or so) prisoners, and will enjoy singing along with some of FEAST partners. It promises to be a great party!

Also, at the end of October we will celebrate "All Hallows Eve," (Halloween) followed on Sunday, November 6, with our observance of All Saints Day. We will remember important people in our church family who have been an inspiration to us, and important people in our families. Lighting candles in their memory and in their honor will bring joy and peace.




