Dear Friedens Family,

This is a special time in the lives of many of us. Thanksgiving is over so it is time to put up the Christmas tree! When our children were young, we usually made a trip to the tree farm on the Saturday after Thanksgiving to pick a tree. A "real" tree was more than we could afford, but it was important to us. Each year we spotted a tree that looked just right for our needs, but then we walked up and down the rows to look at other trees. We usually came back and bought the first tree we had spotted.

One year we were on our way home with our tree in the back of the pickup. We didn't tie it down and were surprised when the wind blew the tree out of our pickup box and into the ditch. What surprised us even more was when a farm truck came from the opposite direction, a man jumped out of the truck and threw our tree into the back of his truck and drove off! The kids were angry and hurt. They wanted me to chase him down and get the tree back. Instead we went back to the tree farm and picked out a second tree.

I guess that is one version of Black Friday. Only this was Black Saturday. The second tree was more than we could afford but we bought it anyway. Once the tree was up and decorated we all forgot about that first choice tree.

On November 27th, we held the tradition of the "hanging of the greens" at Friedens. What a nice tradition that is! We decorated the sanctuary, got out the Advent wreath, put the Advent candles in place and set up our tree. We have a brand new tree this year!

Then, like all children everywhere, we will put our Christmas enthusiasm on hold and begin the wait. Advent is the season of waiting and anticipating. It is easy for us to think we are simply waiting for Christmas to come so we can open our gifts. But Advent is so much more than that. The waiting for Christmas is symbolic of our wait for God to complete the work he has begun. We wait with longing for a day when there will really be peace on earth. We wait for a day when everyone will share in the good life that we tend to take for granted. We wait for the fulfillment of the hope that life on earth will be "as it is in heaven."

That is a great, but wonderful mystery. Christ will come again. We say it over and over every time we gather for worship. While we wait, we hope. It will happen in God's time and in God's own way. We trust that to be true.

Meanwhile we wait. Meanwhile we live in Advent anticipation.

Message from our Council President

New Lift Project

When you come to the church, you will see that the construction of the new lift is now underway. The old lift has been demo'd, and they are making the old shaft area larger, to hold the new lift. The time line for the completion of the new lift is March 1st. So we will have it operational for Easter Services. Our goal is to have it completely paid for by the time it is completed. Of the estimated \$130,000 cost of this project, we have raised approximately \$101,000. Our goal is to not incur any debt for Friedens, when the new lift is completed. If you would like to contribute to this worthy project, you can do so by either mailing your donation to the church office, or by making a donation online at www.friedens.org. If mailing in a check, please mark it "Lift donation". If contributing online, please e-mail the church office afterwards and let them know that your online donation was for the new lift. We have had some very generous donations, from Friedens members and from friends of Friedens, to get us to the \$101,000 mark. We hope that we can close the \$29,000 gap and get this project paid for. Any size donation matters. If you would like more information on this, feel free to contact me personally. Thank you to all who have donated to our new lift, and thank you in advance to those of you who will be donating to this project that Friedens needs so badly, so that we can accommodate people who would like to attend worship services, weddings and funerals. 






Worship by E-mail
