### Message from our Council President

All of the permits have been approved, and work on our new lift should start this month. Now we have to raise the funds to pay for it.

The total estimated cost for the new lift will be around \$130,000.00. Right now, with what we had in our lift fund, and with some very generous donations that we have already received, we have \$70,000 in our lift fund. We have another generous donor, that will match donations from this point, up to \$30,000. That means if we can raise another \$30,000 in donations, we will have \$130,000.00 in our lift fund, and will not have to take out any type of a loan to pay for the lift. We will have raised the entire amount needed for this project. That would truly be remarkable.

Anything received after todays date, will be matched up to \$30,000. This is a way to make your donation go as far as it can, and get the lift paid for without any debt. Any size donation will be appreciated and will make a difference.






