Dear Friedens Family,

As I look around the country where some of my children live, I see lots of places where there is rain, in some places, lots of rain! Little Rock, 4 inches; Denver, 3 inches of rain and snow mix; Houston, 5 inches; Daytona Beach, 3 inches; Columbus, 4 inches; and so it goes. Then I look at Lincoln and see we had .80 inch of rain last week. Nebraska has been called the Great American Desert and so we are grateful for every hundredth of an inch of precipitation, in any form. But, I must admit, I do look with a bit of envy at some of these other places out of concern for dry lawns and Nebraska farmers who are preparing to plant crops.

The season of Lent is passing by very quickly. On Wednesday evenings we have heard brief conversations between Jesus and

But then comes the joy! Easter! News of a resurrection! Not only for Jesus but for us as well!

Oh, death, where is your power, your sting? We do have doubts and fears. Our eyes do get filled with tears at times. But our Lord is alive, seated on a throne, listening, watching, loving, forgiving, healing. Just a little talk with Jesus makes us whole, makes things right.

We will have this new lift, that will last decades, and because of the generosity of Friedens members and friends, Frieden's will not incur any on going debt to pay for it. This is something that a few years ago, we could not even have imagined. Around 20 years ago, when Pastor Nystrom was our transitional Pastor after Pastor Klover retired, I remember Pastor Nystrom telling us at council meetings, that sometimes you just have to do things by faith. I think that rings very true for me with our lift project. We started a few years back trying to figure out how to do this, and at that time, we thought the cost would be around \$30,000. As we got more and more into what actually was involved in putting in a new lift, we found that that cost wasn't very realistic. But no matter how the price of this endeavor continued to go up and up, we knew that it was something that we just had to do and had to trust, have faith, that there would be a way.

Come celebrate Easter and our new lift on Easter Sunday. Hope to see you there.






Inside view of the lift installation and finishing work to be completed




#### FRIEDENS SUNDAY SCHOOL
