Annual Reports for 2016

Education Ministry

Adult Education

Adult Bible Study meets each Thursday morning at Friedens in the Annex from 10:00-11:00. The group is self-lead and reads through a book of scripture while discussing what they have read.

The Sunday morning Adult class has adopted a new format: coffee and conversation for the first 15-20 minutes followed by a 30 minute discussion/lesson. Topics covered have included: cultural art of Jesus, Lutheran-Roman Catholic dialogue, other denominations, some current events, and toward the end of the year, a 500th anniversary of the Reformation study was begun with Luther's Small Catechism.

An Evening Bible Study was offered in the Fall on the book of Acts, but ended due to lack of participation.

Confirmation

Confirmation youth met on Wednesday nights during the school year, except during the seasons of Lent and Advent, when they participated in mid-week services instead. Confirmation is being held in partnership with Grace Lutheran Church at 22nd and Washington. Pastor Eric Lesher (Grace) and Pastor Kate Woolf (Friedens) take turns leading the class. On some weeks the confirmands from Friedens have met with Pastor Kate for some additional confirmation work. In 2016 we finished our year on Lutheran Confessions and started "Living Lutheran". Both are from Sparkhouse's "Collaborate" curriculum.
